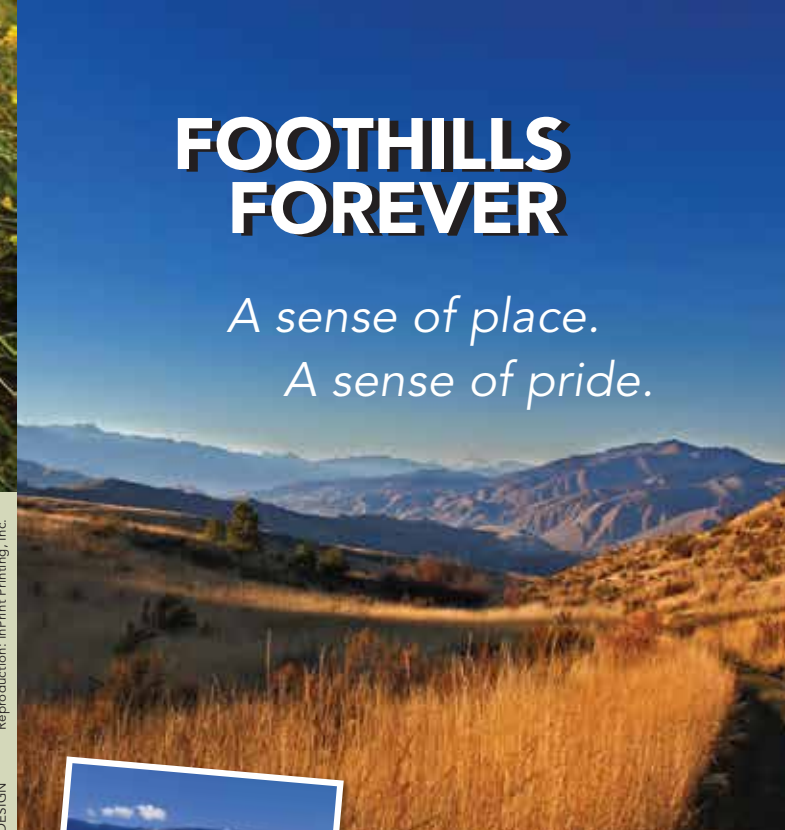

Stand about anywhere in the Wenatchee area, and your attention will be drawn to the community's beautiful skyline, the Wenatchee Foothills, towering to the west.



Take a step into the Foothills, and the experience gets even better — hillsides blanketed with balsamroot and lupine, a coyote skirting ahead, vistas that look back at the valley below and the Cascades in the distance.

Right out the city's back door, the Foothills are a paradise for naturalists and educators. For the artist and photographer, they provide amazing settings and scenes. For the adrenaline junkie, it's loaded with hiking, trail running and mountain biking opportunities.



## The Foothills are for everyone

The population in the Wenatchee Valley continues to grow. Pressure from development in and around the Foothills is increasing.

Through a series of community meetings attended by 1,600 people, we learned that

landowners, business leaders, developers, conservationists and recreationists agree on what lands in the Foothills to protect. Based on this strategy, Chelan-Douglas Land Trust, with support from The Trust for Public Land, has launched an \$8.1 million fundraising campaign to purchase and care for key properties and trails in the Foothills.

Residents and visitors will enjoy improved access with the addition of more trailheads, and better care of trails and critical habitat through ongoing stewardship.

We will have a world-class community asset that ensures a distinctly livable community for generations to come — one that strikes a unique balance between development, wildlife and recreation.

When these projects are complete, the acreage available to the public will more than double.
